ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION INTO NATIONAL/HIGHER NATIONAL DIPLOMA/POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES OF THE ACADEMY

A. National Diploma Programme

The Admission process into National Diploma programmes of the Academy is through Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB)/Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME).

1. Candidates who are interested in the programmes of the Academy must sit for UTME.
2. List of successful candidates are always forwarded to the Academy for further action after the examination.
3. Screening/Aptitude Test:
 - a) Candidates are subjected to screening exercise/Aptitude Test as may from time to time be decided by the Management/Regulatory Authority.
 - b) Candidates must pass Medical Examination and Physical Fitness before he/she can be considered for admission.

Entry Requirements:

1. Nautical science

Five (5) credit passes at O/Level (WASC, GCE, NECO, NABTEB etc) not more than two (2) sittings.

Subjects Required:

- a) English Language
- b) Mathematics
- c) Physics or Geography
- d) And any other one (1) subject from Chemistry, Biology etc

2. Marine Engineering

Five (5) credit passes at O/Level (WASC, GCE, NECO, NABTEB etc) in not more than two (2) sittings.

Subjects Required:

- a) English Language
- b) Mathematics
- c) Physics
- d) And any other two (2) subjects from Chemistry, Biology, Technical Drawing etc

3. Electrical/Electronics

Five (5) credit passes at O/level (WASC, GCE, NECO, NABTEB etc) in not more than two (2) sittings.

Subjects Required

- a) English Language
- b) Mathematics
- c) Physics
- d) And any other two (2) Science subjects.

4. Maritime Transport and Business Studies

Five (5) credit passes at O/Level (WASC, GCE, NECO, NABTEB etc) in not more than two (2) sittings.

Subjects Required:

- a) English Language
- b) Mathematics
- c) Economics
- d) And any other two (2) subjects from Commerce, Government, Principles of Account, Business Management etc

5. Age Limit

- a) (Serials 1 – 2 under the Entry Requirements) should not be more than 21 years at the time of admission and shall be single and remain single throughout the duration of the programme.
- b) (Serial 3-5) should not be more than 25 years at the time of admission and shall be single and remain single throughout the duration of the programme.

B. Requirements for Admission into Higher National Diploma Programmes

The following programmes are on offer:

- i) Nautical Science (2 years) of four Semester
- ii) Marine Engineering (2 years) of four Semester
- iii) Maritime Transport Management (2 years) of four Semester

Applicants for Higher National Diploma in Nautical and Marine Engineering Must:

- i] Possess the Senior School Certificate Examination (SSCE) or its equivalent with at least FIVE CREDIT passes in subjects which must include Mathematics, English Language, Physics, and any two of Geography, Technical Drawing and Chemistry, obtained at NOT MORE THAN TWO SITTINGS.
- ii] Possess a National Diploma in Nautical Science, Marine Engineering with a Cumulative Grade Point Average of not less than 2.50 (Lower Credit) From the Maritime Academy of Nigeria or from accredited institution listed with Joint Admission and Matriculation Board (JAMB). Also, candidates must have JAMB Registration number and
- iii] Have completed a minimum of one-year Post-ND Industrial Training with evidence or must have acquired a minimum of one year Cognate Work Experience in a relevant organization.
- iv] Candidates with **PASS** at National Diploma level from Maritime Academy of Nigeria and other accredited institution must have completed a minimum of two years Post-ND Industrial Training with evidence or must have acquired a two years cognate Work Experience in a relevant organisation.

Applicants for Higher National Diploma (HND) in Maritime Transport

Management Must:

- i] Possess the Senior School Certificate Examination (SSCE) or its equivalent with at least FIVE CREDIT passes in subjects which must include Mathematics, English Language, Economics, and any other two of Commerce, Government, Principle of Account and Business Management, obtained at NOT MORE THAN TWO SITTINGS.

- ii] Possess a National Diploma in Maritime Transport and Business Studies with a Cumulative Grade Point Average of not less than 2.50 (Lower Credit) From the Maritime Academy of Nigeria or from accredited institution listed with Joint Admission and Matriculation Board (JAMB). Also, candidates must have JAMB Registration number and

- iii] Have completed a minimum of one-year Post-ND Industrial Training with evidence or acquired a minimum of one-year Cognate Work Experience in a relevant organization.

- iv] Candidate with **PASS** at National Diploma level from Maritime Academy of Nigeria and other accredited Institution must have completed a minimum of two years Post-ND Industrial Training with evidence or acquired a two years cognate Work Experience in a relevant organisation.
